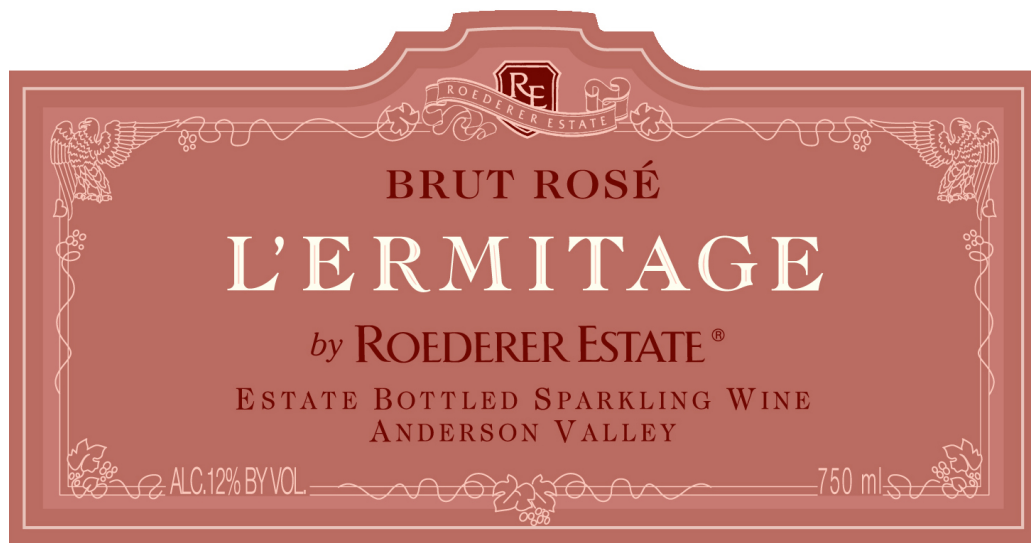

"The result is a rosé that has flavor depth without tasting fruity. It achieves the stylistic goals of Roederer's wines from Champagne: freshness and finesse. This wine is delicate, with hints of caramel, subtle earthy complexity and fruit depth to balance it. Fine bubbles carry the flavors on a clean line. Classical, if such a thing can be said of a California sparkling wine."
